Sermon: Grad Service - Formed for Revival

Text: Acts 1:12–14; 2:1–4

Pentecost reminds us that revival is often the overflow of surrendered discipleship. The Holy Spirit does not simply stir emotion or excitement outwardly, but transforms and sanctifies us inwardly. The clearest evidence of the Spirit is not merely passion, but a life becoming more like Jesus.

1 – Open/Check-In

Have you ever felt unusually empowered or “unstoppably confident” doing something? (Sports, parenting, fixing something, public speaking, cooking, surviving Costco, etc.) Why? What happened?

2 – The Word / Acts 1:12–14; 2:1–4

What stands out to you in these passages?

3 – Reflect

1. Why do people sometimes seek spiritual excitement more than spiritual transformation?
2. What does true holiness and Christlike transformation look like in everyday life?

4 – Respond (Spiritual Formation/Growth)

1. Is Jesus truly Lord over every area of your life—or mostly an inspiration we add alongside other priorities?
2. Where is the Holy Spirit wanting to shape, sanctify, or change you inwardly?

5 – Pray Together

Pray for surrendered hearts, true repentance, holiness, and deeper transformation through the Holy Spirit.

but lives fully surrendered to Jesus and transformed by the Holy Spirit.*
