Sermon: Life Lessons Dads Can Learn from Joseph
Text: Matthew 1:19–24; 2:13–14

Joseph never speaks a recorded word in Scripture, yet his life speaks volumes. He was not famous, powerful, wealthy, or celebrated. He was simply faithful. When life did not go according to plan, Joseph trusted God, obeyed God's direction, protected his family, and quietly fulfilled the role God had given him.

1 – Open/Check-In

2 – The Word / Matthew 1:19–24; 2:13–14

3 – Reflect

Which statement do you find most meaningful right now? Why?

- (b) Obedience matters more than understanding.
- (c) Character matters more than recognition.
- (d) Protection matters more than pride.

What stands out to you about Joseph's response when his plans were suddenly changed?

4 – Respond (Spiritual Formation/Growth)

Is there an area of your life where God may be asking you to trust Him before you fully understand what He is doing?

Isaiah 40:31 says those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. What helps you remain spiritually strong when life becomes difficult or uncertain?

5 – Pray Together

Thank God for the people whose faithfulness has shaped your life. Let's be a people who faithfully show up, trust God when life changes unexpectedly, and obey Him even when the path ahead is not fully clear.
