Sermon: The Pathway to See God's Glory
Text: John 15:7-8

Jesus teaches that a fruitful life begins by remaining connected to Him. Prayer is not merely asking God for things—it is living in relationship with Him. As we abide in Christ, our desires are shaped by His will, our lives bear fruit, and God is glorified.

1 – Open/Check-In

4 – Respond (Spiritual Formation/Growth)

Research consistently shows that regular engagement with God's Word transforms lives. What habit helps you stay connected to Scripture and prayer throughout the week?

What is one practical step you can take this week to spend more intentional time abiding in Christ?

5 – Pray Together

Spend time praying for one another's relationship with Christ.
