Sermon: ***Room for More***

Text: Luke 14:12–24 & 1 Timothy 2:1–6

1 – Pray Together [the first and most important priority]

"If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here." — Exodus 33:15

Take time to share needs and pray for one another. Ask God to give you His heart for people and to bring someone to mind who may need an invitation, encouragement, or reminder that there is room for them.

Jesus describes the kingdom of God as a great banquet. Some who were invited made excuses, so the host sent his servant into the streets and beyond, saying, "There is still room." God's heart reaches outward. He welcomes people others may overlook and calls His followers to make room so others can find their way home.

2 – Open/Check-In

Who is someone who helped you feel welcomed or included at an important time in your life?

3 – The Word / Luke 14:12–24 & 1 Timothy 2:1–6

What stands out to you in these passages?

4 – Reflect

What do the words "There is still room" reveal about the heart of God?

What can keep us from noticing, caring about, or reaching beyond the people already in our circle?

5 – Respond (Spiritual Formation/Growth)

Who might represent an "empty chair" in your life right now—someone God is inviting you to pray for, care for, or invite?

What is one simple step you can take toward that person this week?

There is still room. Who might God use you to help find their way home?
